The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on January 4, 2021 at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:25 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees: Russ Patrick, Dave Charles, Gina Rusciollelli, Joe Bartley, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Tom Rader.

Trustee Bartley made a motion to approve December 21st regular board meeting minutes and pay the bills. It was seconded by Trustee Rusciollelli. Trustees Patrick, Charles, Rusciollelli, Bartley, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Mayor Rader requested to move Ord #21-001 An Ordinance Vacating Portions of Spaulding St. until after Executive Session.

Superintendent Lyons submitted his report. Trustee Rusciollelli inquired about water and gas leaks. Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve Brotcke Well & Pump to replace a pump at well #4 for \$16,647.80. Trustee Patrick seconded. Trustees Patrick, Charles, Rusciollelli, Bartley, Mileham, and Landess voted yes. Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve an annual maintenance agreement with Brotcke Well & Pump for \$4500. Trustee Rusciollelli seconded. Trustees Patrick, Charles, Rusciollelli, Bartley, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Chief Lawley submitted his report.

Office Manager Patterson was not in attendance, and had nothing to report.

Treasurer Baker reminded Trustees that budget worksheets are out and they are due March 1st. She also requested a list of explanation of projects to be budgeted.
