### Riverton Village Board

The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on February 1, 2021 at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees: Russ Patrick, Gina Rusciollelli, Joe Bartley, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Tom Rader. Trustee Dave Charles was absent

The week of February 15<sup>th</sup> will bring grading, storm sewer, and de-watering systems. The week of March 1<sup>st</sup> will bring the building being delivered. The week of March 24<sup>th</sup> the tanks will be delivered and installed. The building site and foundation will be installed with the tanks are set. The developer has a 5 month deadline for completion. All contractors have agreed to work through the

weather. The “Coming Soon T/A Tuck Stop” with restaurant signage will be installed and there will be a groundbreaking ceremony. He also met with Ryan McGrady, President and CEO of Springfield Sangamon Growth Alliance and discussed economic development in Riverton. They are also working on developing a Business Directory for Riverton and will be looking for information for in-home based businesses.

Mayor Rader stated that the village is in a good position for expanding. He also stated that there are local contractors working on the I72 project.

Trustee Bartley made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:13 pm. Trustee Patrick seconded. Trustees Patrick, Rusciollelli, Bartley, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.
