Riverton Village Board

The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on April 5, 2021 at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees: Dave Charles, Gina Rusciollelli, Joe Bartley, Jim Mileham, and Mayor Tom Rader. Trustee Russ Patrick and Michelle Landess were absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Trustee Bartley made a motion to approve March 1st regular board meeting pay the bills. It was seconded by Trustee Mileham. Trustees Charles, Rusciollelli, Bartley, and Mileham voted yes.

Mayor Rader asked for a moment of silence in honor of Tom Runyon who passed away on Friday. He was the Clearlake Township Supervisor and a lifelong resident of the Riverton area.
