The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on May 17, 2021 at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees: Russ Patrick, Dave Charles, Gina Rusciollelli, Jim Mileham, and Mayor Tom Rader. Joe Bartley and Michelle Landess were not in attendance.

Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve May 3rd board meeting minutes and pay the bills. It was seconded by Trustee Patrick. Trustees Patrick, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham voted yes.

Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve Ordinance #21-012 An Ordinance Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Village of Buffalo. Trustee Patrick seconded. Trustees Patrick, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham voted yes.

Village Engineer Kuhn reported that the MFT was approved. They are currently working on Rural Development. He reported that the money coming from Representative Butler is progressing and will fund a mill and overlay project.
