The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on June 21, 2021 at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

Trustee Bartley made a motion to approve June 7th board meeting minutes and pay the bills. It was seconded by Trustee Rusciollelli. Trustees Patrick, Charles, Rusciollelli, Bartley, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.
