

## Utility Rate Analysis and Changes Effective 1/1/14

In accordance with Section 50G of the Riverton Municipal Code, the Administrative Committee has reviewed the most recent audit report for the Village of Riverton and is reporting the following rate adjustments for utilities effective 1/1/14

### **ELECTRIC**

(1) Residential– inside corporate limits of Riverton.

Up to 10 kwh	Current Rate	Rate Effective 1/1/14

(2) Commercial and governmental– inside or outside corporate limits of Riverton.

## GAS

(A) The base monthly rate for natural gas service inside corporate city limits of the village based on furnishing one thousand BTU per cubic foot natural gas at sixty degrees Fahrenheit are as follows:

(1) For general and space heating use:

(a) First one thousand cu. ft.

## SEWER

(a) The monthly charge for sewer services shall be based on the amount of water consumed as measured at the customer's meter, as follows:

1. All users– inside corporate limits of Riverton:

Demand charge– for availability of sewage treatment and for treatment of up to first one thousand gallons:

For water used in excess of one thousand gallons:

2. All users– outside corporate limits of Riverton:

Demand charge– for availability of sewage treatment and for treatment of up to first one thousand gallons:

For water used in excess of one thousand gallons:

3. Surcharge for Exceptional Loads. For users of the sewage system with sewage discharge concentrations exceeding two hundred mg/l BOD or two hundred sixty-six mg/l SS, there will be a surcharge, as follows:

per pound of BOD: \$ .250 per pound

per pound of SS: \$ .1914 per pound

(b) Minimum payment for persons who are obligated to connect to the village sewage system: All persons who are required by Section 54.004 of this code of ordinances to connect to the village sewer system, but who have not done so, shall be liable to pay the demand charge of
