Riverton Village Board

The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on July 6, 2026, at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees, Johnathan Chisam, Paul Baker, Joshua Zirkelbach, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Pro Tem Dave Charles. Mayor Joe Baartley was not in attendance.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve June 15th board meeting minutes and pay the bills. It was seconded by Trustee Landess. Trustees, Chisam, Charles, Baker, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess, voted yes.

Trustee Landess, chairperson of the Public Works Committee, made a motion to approve Ron Furman's for asphalt roads for \$47,052. Trustee Zirkelbach seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Baker, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes. She also will bring a list of roads to be chipped and oiled to the next meeting and gave an update on the Jamestown drainage problems.
