Riverton Village Board

The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on June 1, 2026, at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees, Johnathan Chisam, Dave Charles, Paul Baker, Joshua Zirkelbach, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Joe Bartley.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve May 18th board meeting minutes and pay the bills. It was seconded by Trustee Landess. Trustees, Chisam, Charles, Baker, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Trustee Charles, chairperson of the Parks Committee, gave an update on projects at Field of Dreams. They are locating field tiles for drainage for the pond and waiting for designs for the Splash pad.

Trustee Landess, chairperson of the Public Works Committee, reported that she would talk to Superintendent Lyons regarding placement of stop signs.

Trustee Baker, chairperson of the Economic Development Committee, had nothing to report

Mayor Bartley, reported that he was working with Mayors of other small towns in Sangamon County regarding money set aside for road projects that was re-appropriated to Springfield.

Trustee Chisam made a motion to enter Executive Session at 7:14 pm. Trustee Landess seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Baker, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Trustee Zirkelbach made a motion to re-enter Open Session at 7:35 pm. Trustee Chisam seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Baker, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Trustee Chisam made a motion on behalf of the Public Safety Committee to hire Patrick Schweitzer as Police Chief effective June 15, 2026, at \$46 per hour. Trustee Charles seconded. Trustees Charles, Baker, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes. Trustee Chisam voted no.

Trustee Landess made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:37 pm. Trustee Zirkelbach seconded. Trustees, Chisam, Charles, Baker, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.
