Riverton Village Board

The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on June 15, 2026, at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees, Dave Charles, Joshua Zirkelbach, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Joe Bartley. Trustees Johnathan Chisam and Paul Baker were not in attendance.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve June 1st board meeting minutes and pay the bills. It was seconded by Trustee Landess. Trustees, Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

People to Address the Board:

Lisa Robinson addressed the board concerning a property in the Riveria subdivision with shipping containers. Chief Crouch will look at the property and Mayor Bartely will follow up with the Attorney on shipping container ordinance possibilities.

Patrick Scheweitzer was sworn in as the new Chief of Police.

Village Engineer Kuhn, reported on drainage for Jamestown residences, Field of Dreams updates, and grants regarding the substation and railroads.

Village Attorney Craven, reported that he is working on behalf of Riverton and other villages on zoning updates and road work money in the county.

Superintendent Lyons, submitted his report.

Chief Crouch, submitted his report. He welcomed new Police Chief Patrick Scheweitzer.

Office Manager Patterson, had nothing to report.

Treasurer March, was not in attendance and had nothing to report.

Committee Reports:

Trustee Zirkelbach, chairperson of the Administrative Committee, made a motion to approve the purchase of a new server from Lloyd IT services not to exceed \$5,500. Trustee Mileham seconded. Trustees Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Trustee Chisam, chairperson of the Public Safety Committee, was not in attendance.

Trustee Mileham, chairperson of the Public Utility Committee, thanked village employees for their work during the electrical outage after the severe weather. Concerns regarding Comcast are ongoing and were addressed.

Trustee Charles, chairperson of the Parks Committee, gave an update on projects at Field of Dreams. He announced the Fishing Derby for Friday and Saturday from 8-12. He also referenced letters from youth who had vandalized Veteran's Park and they had submitted letters of apology and a fee for the damage.

Trustee Landess, chairperson of the Public Works Committee, made a motion to approve Top Notch tree service to remove a tree in the right of way on 6th and Jefferson for \$1000. Trustee Charles seconded. Trustees Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes. She also reported that the road work in Silent Rain would be cut and refilled to address the issue brought forward by a citizen at the last meeting.

Trustee Baker, chairperson of the Economic Development Committee, was not in attendance and had nothing to report

Mayor Bartley, reported that he was working with Mayors of other small towns in Sangamon County regarding money set aside for road projects that was re-appropriated to Springfield, and zoning regarding solar farms on agricultural land near villages.

Trustee Landess made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 pm. Trustee Zirkelbach seconded. Trustees, Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.
