Riverton Village Board

The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on May 18, 2026, at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees, Johnathan Chisam, Dave Charles, Paul Baker, Joshua Zirkelbach, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Joe Bartley.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Mayor Bartley requested the bill for WR Diesel Performance be removed from the bills to be paid. Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve May 4th board meeting minutes and pay the bills with the bill removed for WR Diesel Performance. It was seconded by Trustee Landess. Trustee Landess made a motion to approve Resolution 26-03 A Resolution In Support of Sangamon County Zoning Amendment. Trustee Chisam seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Baker, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.
