Riverton Village Board

The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on August 19, 2024 at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees: Dave Charles, Gina Rusciollelli, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Joe Bartley. Trustee Chisam arrived at 7:04 pm.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve August 5th board meeting minutes and pay the bills. It was seconded by Trustee Landess. Trustees Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham, Landess, and Mayor Bartley voted yes.

People to Address the Board:

Pat Mileham addressed the board on behalf of the senior luncheon. She inquired about a replacement for the coffee maker in the kitchen. The board will look for a replacement.

Committee Reports:

Trustee Chisam, chairperson of the Administrative Committee, had nothing to report.

Trustee Rusciollelli, chairperson of the Public Safety Committee, thanked the Police Department for their work for the National Night Event.

Trustee Mileham, chairperson of the Public Utility Committee, made a motion to approve \$1225 for five employees to attend a water conference. Trustee Charles seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham, Landess, and Mayor Bartley voted yes. Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve up to \$500 to send one employee to a Pipe Line Safety training. Trustee Rusciollelli seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham, Landess, and Mayor Bartley voted yes.

Trustee Charles, chairperson of the Parks Committee, reported that the OSLAD grant was changed to include five feet paths instead of ten feet paths to reduce the cost.

Trustee Landess, chairperson of the Public Works Committee, made a motion to approve 13 sections of sidewalk replacements not to exceed \$20,000. Trustee Rusciollelli seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham, Landess, and Mayor Bartley voted yes. Trustee Landess made a motion to approve 9

roads for oil and chipping. Trustee Rusciollelli seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham, Landess, and Mayor Bartley voted yes.

Mayor Bartley, chairperson of the Economic Development Committee, reported that the reduction in the food tax effective January 1 will reduce the Villages tax income by approximately \$48,000. The Illinois Municipal League sent a model for no camping on public grounds and Attorney Craven will review it.

Trustee Rusciollelli made a motion to enter into executive session at 7:17 pm. Trustee Landess seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham, Landess, and Mayor Bartley voted yes.

Trustee Rusciollelli made a motion to reenter open session at 7:25 pm. Trustee Landess seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham, Landess, and Mayor Bartley voted yes.

Trustee Rusciollelli made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:27 pm. Trustee Charles seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham, Landess, and Mayor Bartley voted yes.
