The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on August 5, 2024 at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees: Johnathan Chisam, Dave Charles, Gina Rusciollelli, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Joe Bartley.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve July 15th board meeting minutes and pay the bills. It was seconded by Trustee Landess. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham, Landess, and Mayor Bartley voted yes.

Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve Ordinance 24-21 An Ordinance Of The Village of Riverton, Sangamon County, Illinois Authorizing The Execution Of A New Power Sales Contract With The Illinois Municipal Electric Agency For The Delivery Period Commencing October 1, 2035. Mayor Bartley reported that the USDA water main expansion project is being appealed. He recommended moving forward with money from the short lived asset fund to fund materials.
