The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on November 4, 2024 at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees: Johnathan Chisam, Dave Charles, Gina Rusciollelli, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Joe Bartley.

Trustee Charles made a motion to approve Ordinance 24-28 An Ordinance For The Levy And Assessment Of Taxes For The Village Of Riverton, Illinois, For The Fiscal Year Beginning May 1, 2024 And Ending April 30, 2025 for \$230,626.24. Trustee Mileham seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Rusciollelli, Mileham, Landess, and Mayor Bartley voted yes.

Superintendent Lyons, submitted his report. Trustee Rusciollelli requested that owners be notified in writing regarding the water extension. Superintendent Lyons and Mayor Bartley will write a letter.
